4. **LIBRARIAN SUGGESTIONS:**
 - Nature (single flowers of all colors so we can make a rainbow.)
 - Wildlife (from various countries or the zoo)
 - Domestic Pets (all kinds- lizards, birds, cats, dogs, horses, bunnies, goats, etc..)
 - Transportation (bicycles, boats, buses, cars, trains, skateboards, wagons, strollers, etc.)
 - Musical Instruments (piano, guitars, violin, saxophones, trumpet, drums, tambourines.)
 - Toys (blocks, dolls, stuffed animals, small cars, trucks, trains, Lincoln logs, wagons, etc.)
 - Sports (playground equipment, balls, balloons, kites, bats, swimming, skates, etc.)

7. **NO ABSTRACTS, NO TITLES, NO HOLIDAYS, NO RELIGIOUS THEMES. NO LANDSCAPES.**
8. **NO MATS, NO FRAMES, NO GLASS, NO BLACK & WHITE, NO WIRE. NO ENTRY FEES.**
9. Need **100** prints. Back of prints must be signed and dated.
10. Drop-off is **Tuesday, June 3** (10-4) AAFC. Donations only, pick-up not necessary.
