

HOPE & HOME DIGITAL IMAGING GUIDELINES FOR TEENS

Target Audience: Hope & Home Teens, Grades 7 – 12.

Theme: “Color Our World” No black/white or sepia images accepted.

Subjects of Images: Sports, Transportation (No Trains!), Nature, Pets, Wildlife, Space, Humor (things out of place / surprises), Abstract, Landscapes, Seascapes, Skyscapes, Unique Architecture, Culture, Street Scenes. (No horror, nudity, violence, no religious or evil symbols, no faces that can be identified.)

Note: Inspirational / Fun / Colorful / Illustrations encouraged.

Encouraging words work like COURAGE, HOPE, STRENGTH, ENDURANCE.

Multiples of one print are acceptable.

Sizes: A variety of sizes / shapes accepted. Suggested: 4 x 6, 5 x 5, 8 x 10, 8 X 12, 11 x 14.

Finished Images: They may be simply mounted with wire. No frames or glass. They may be laminated or sprayed for longevity. Color prints only. Deliver loose prints in clear sleeve protectors / envelopes. Sharpies and sleeve protectors available at drop off.

Signatures: Back of images with black sharpie. Artist first name / last initial only.

Drop Off: Thursday May 22 from 5:30-7:30 at PDIS Monthly Meeting at Library 21C ,
or Tuesday June 3 11:00-3:00 at Academy Art and Frame (7560 N Academy Blvd)

Notes: All prints will be donated so there is no pick up. We are hoping to collect a minimum of 50 prints. Feel free to ask members from other clubs to join us in this project. It is not necessary to be a PDIS member. Also we would appreciate donations of removable command strips / hooks.
